

North Parkland Power REA Student Scholarship Criteria

North Parkland Power recognizes the tremendous amount of dedication, hard work and educational funding for students to achieve their goals. That is why we developed our Scholarships for Members or their children. We encourage you to apply for the scholarship that best suits your area of expertise. Please note that you may only apply for one scholarship.

\$500 Scholarship for Academic Achievement

Highest Average in 4 grade 12 subjects (English, Sciences, Social Studies, Mathematics or any combination of these totally 4 subjects)

\$500 Volunteerism Scholarship Award

Student must submit a 1000 word essay on why they have chosen to volunteer with the organization(s) they have and how their experience has changed their life.

Student must submit approximate hours completed over the last 3 years. To be considered volunteerism you must demonstrate how you volunteered for which you received no pay, school credits or marks for your contribution. (Work experience, playing on a sports team etc. will not be considered)

Reference letters (2) outlining your volunteerism must be included with your application

\$500 Glenn Nicol Student Leadership Scholarship Award

Student must submit a 1000 word essay on why they how they displayed leadership with the organization(s) they have and how their experience has changed their life. Include in your essay the ways your efforts have strengthened others, how long you have been involved in leadership, what you think the long term impact will be for you because of it, and how your involvement showed initiative and innovation.

Reference letters (2) outlining your involvement must be included with your application

In order to be eligible to receive above mentioned Scholarships, you(r):

Must be a Member or child of a Member of North Parkland Power REA and residing full time in our service area.

Membership, or that of parents, must be at least 1 full year in length, prior to application.

Must have a Valid Electrical Service Contract with North Parkland Power REA and it must be in place at time of application.

Must be currently enrolled in your graduating year of a Canadian High School, and will be enrolled full-time in a degree or diploma program at a recognized publicly funded Canadian university or college in the fall 2016 academic term.

(Please provide proof of acceptance)

Employees of North Parkland Power REA and its subsidiaries, and any child of any of the foregoing are not eligible for the Scholarships. For greater certainty, "child" shall be defined herein as a person whose parent or legal guardian is an employee North Parkland Power REA or any of its subsidiaries.
